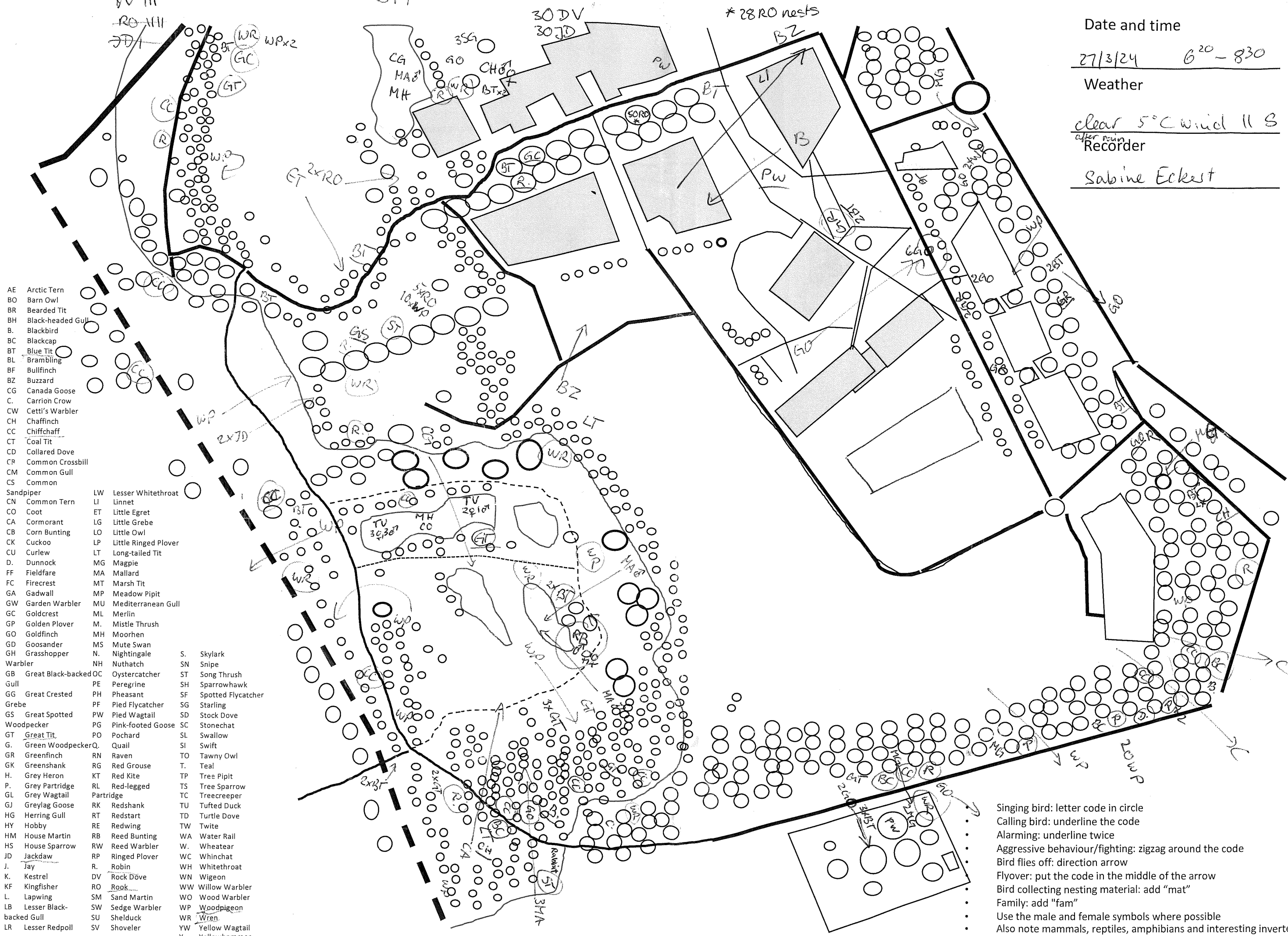

- Singing bird: letter code in circle
- Calling bird: underline the code
- Alarming: underline twice
- Aggressive behaviour/fighting: zigzag around the code
- Bird flies off: direction arrow
- Flyover: put the code in the middle of the arrow
- Bird collecting nesting material: add "mat"
- Family: add "fam"
- Use the male and female symbols where possible
- Also note mammals, reptiles, amphibians and interesting invertebrates
